Powers, founded American300 Tours as an all volunteer NGO AVO 501c3 back in 2006, with the goal of assisting our DoD with Service Member Resiliency Training. Utilizing mentors who personify excellence and resiliency through their own life experiences, the nonprofit has brought subject matter resiliency experts to over 400 bases to date. Powers, served our country as a Infantry NCO and Officer in the US Army Mountain Warfare School as well as on the Armed Forces Sports Biathlon Team.

The former national team biathlete went on to coach for the US Ski Team after his separation from Army AGR Duty in 1989. After 14 years coaching and providing technical service to our National and Olympic Teams, Powers retired from the US Ski Team and took up broadcast work for major sporting events like the Olympics, ESPN X Games and major Marathons across the country. Powers is the co-host of the Marine Corps and Air Force Marathons each year amongst other assignments.

His awards include: 1998 US Ski Team International Coach of Year, 2008 USAF American Spirit Award and 2014 DoD Spirit of Bob Hope Award. American300 programming has become his focus thanks to a wife and family that totally support the effort and military leaders who requested the programming on a monthly basis. He resides with his wife Laila Powers MD in Steamboat Springs, Colorado. They have 5 children.
